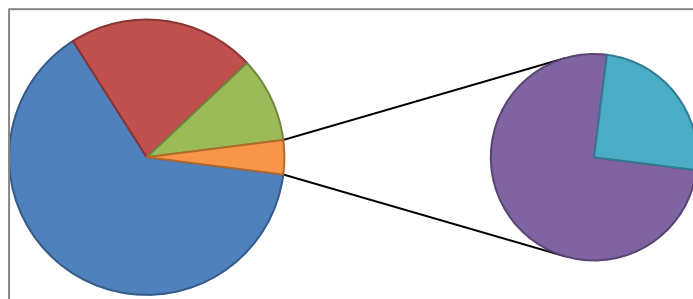


Following is the report of the survey (SSS) based on responses obtained online from 200 students.

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 189 responses

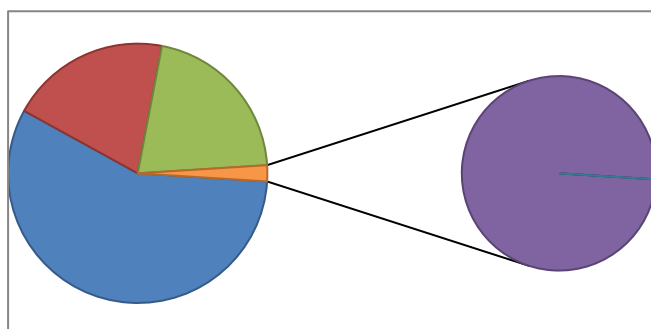

Interpretations:

- ❖ The blue color denotes that 64% of students have said that 85 to 100% of the syllabus has been covered.
- ❖ The red color denotes that 23% of students commented that 70 to 84% of the syllabus has been covered.
- ❖ The green color denotes that 10% of students have reported that 55 to 69% of the syllabus has been completed.
- ❖ The purple color denotes that 3% of students said that 30 to 54% of the syllabus has been done.
- ❖ The light blue color denotes that 1% of students have said that only 30% of the syllabus has been completed.

2. How well did the teachers prepared for the classes? 175 responses

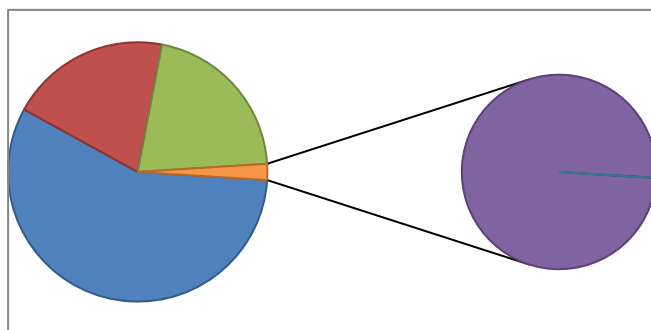

- ❖ The blue color denotes that 57% of students have said that teachers were thoroughly prepared for the classes.

- ❖ The green color denotes that 21% of students have reported that teachers were poorly prepared for the classes.
- ❖ The purple color denotes that 2% of students said that teachers were indifferently prepared for the classes.
- ❖ The light blue color denotes that 0% of students have said that teachers won't teach at all.

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 177 responses

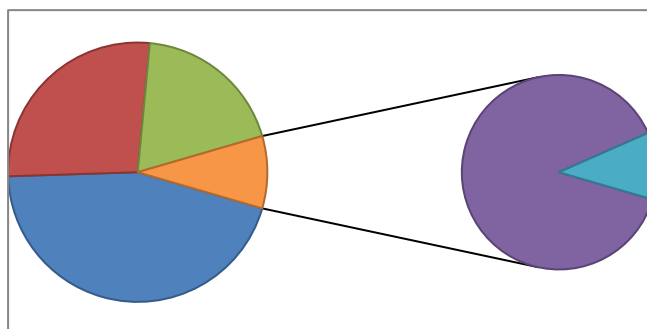

- ❖ The purple color denotes that 2% of students said that teachers were communicating in an ineffective way in class.
- ❖ The light blue color denotes that 0% of students have said that teachers have very poor communication in the class.

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can be described as. 169 responses

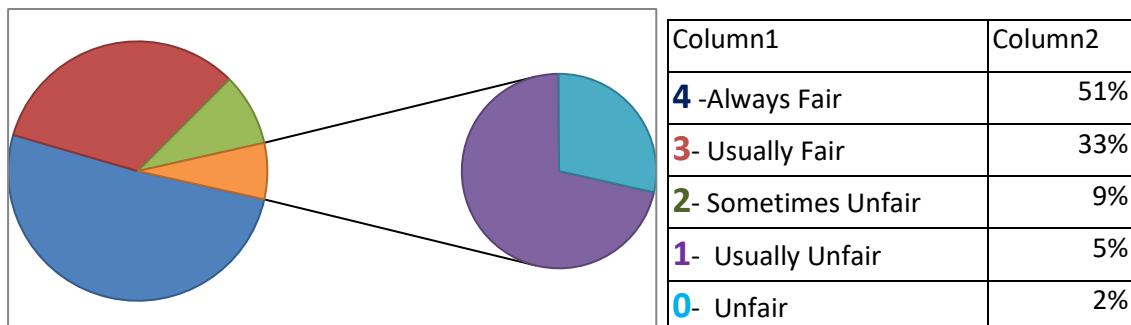

- ❖ The light blue color denotes that 1% of students have said that teacher's approach was poor in class.

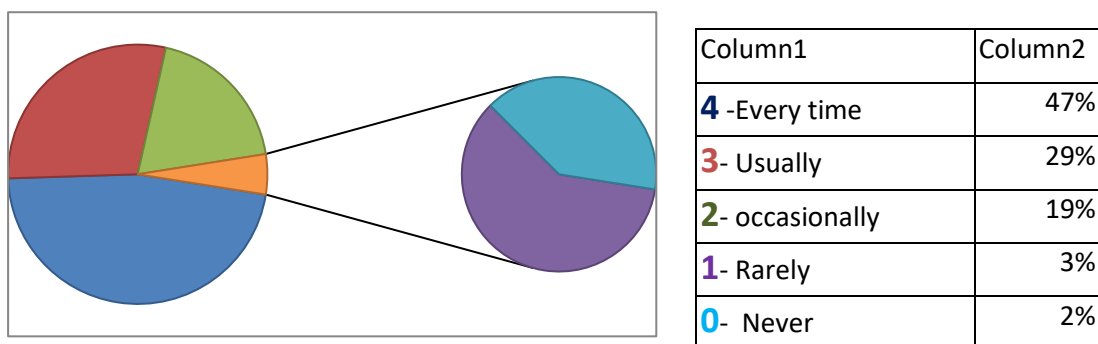
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 176responses

- ❖ The light blue color denotes that 2% of students have said that teachers were Unfair in the internal evaluation.

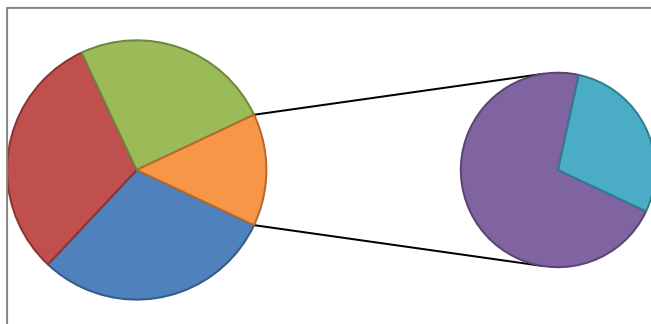
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 165 responses

- ❖ The blue color denotes that 47% of students have said that their assignments were discussed every time in the class.

- ❖ The purple color denotes that 3% of students said that their assignments were rarely discussed in the class.

7. Does the institute take active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, and field opportunities for students? 177 responses

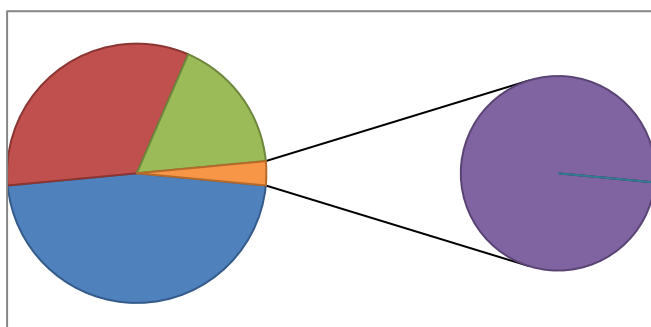

8. Does the teaching and monitoring process in your institution facilitate you in cognitive, emotional and social growth? 181 responses



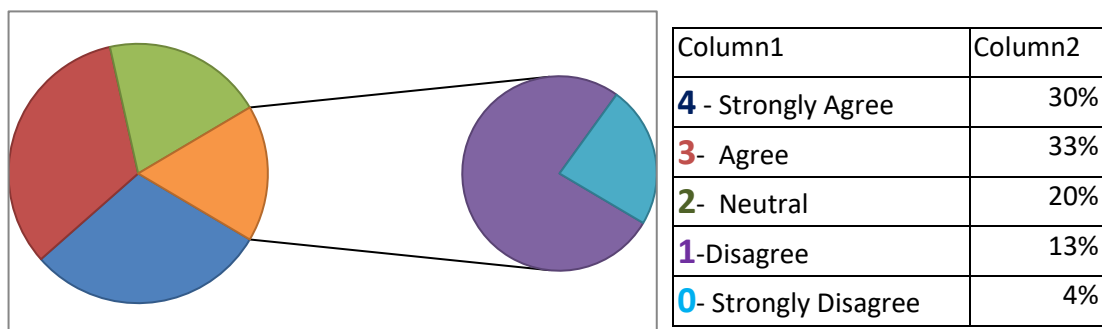

9. Does the institute provide multiple opportunities to learn and grow?

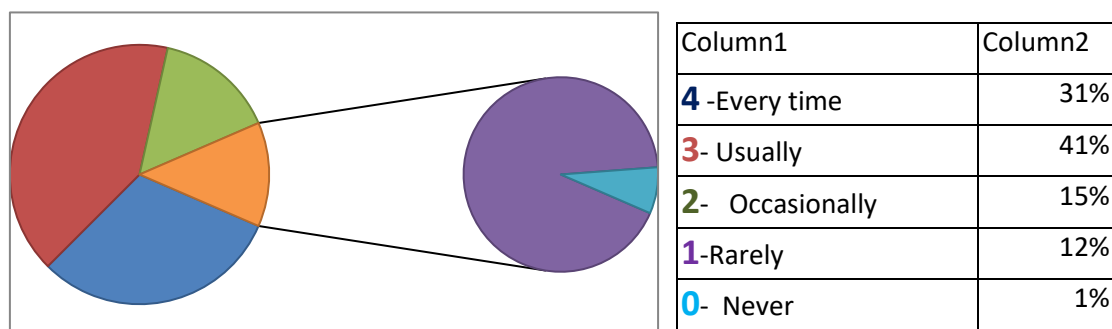

- ❖ [The light blue color denotes that 4% of students are strongly disagreeing.](#)

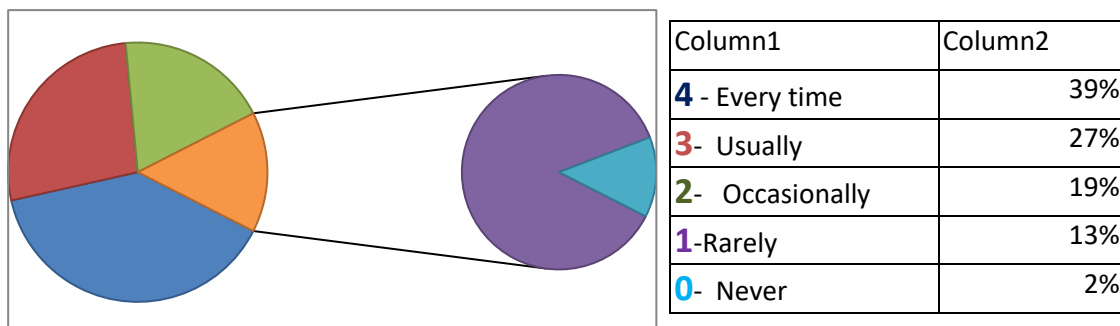
10. Do teachers inform you about your competencies, course outcomes and programs outcomes? 179 responses

11. Does your mentor do a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you? 165 responses

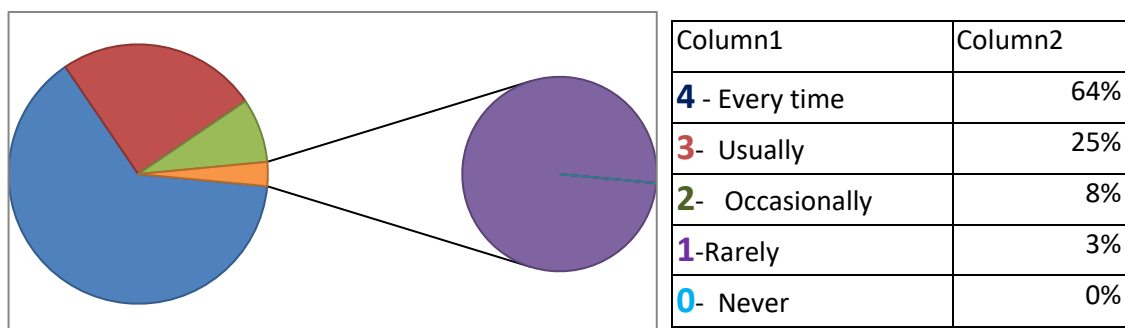


Interpretations:

12. Do the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications?

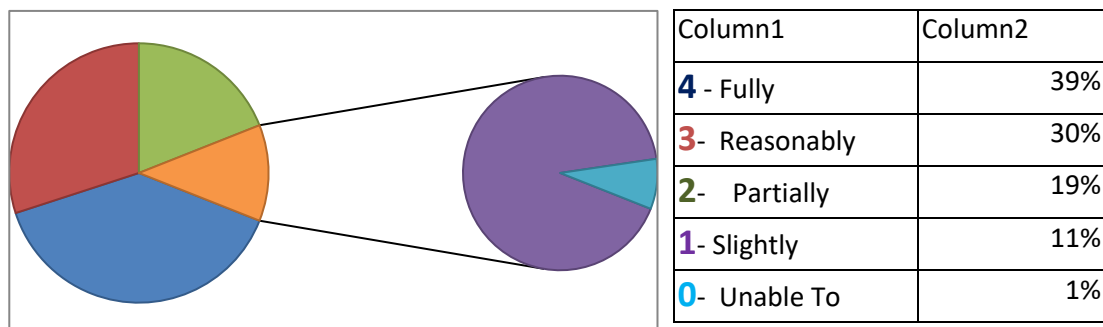

- ❖ The light blue color denotes that 0% of students have said that the teachers never illustrates through examples and applications.

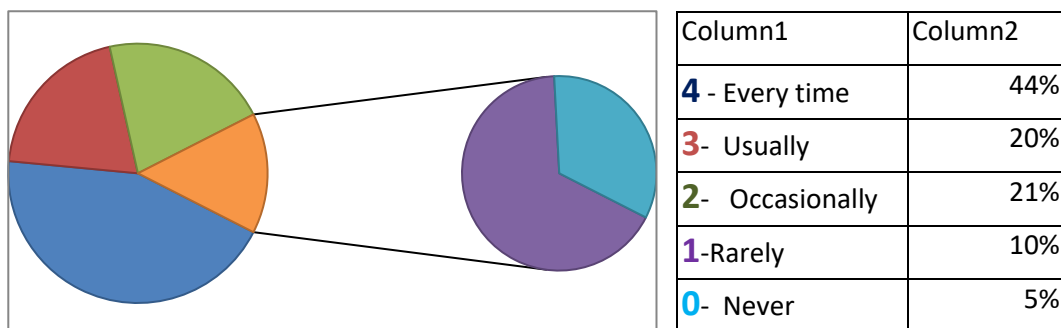
13. Do the teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges? 179 responses

14. Do the teachers able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them?181responses



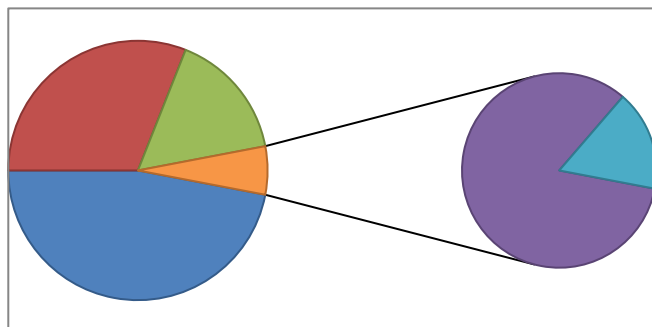
Interpretations:

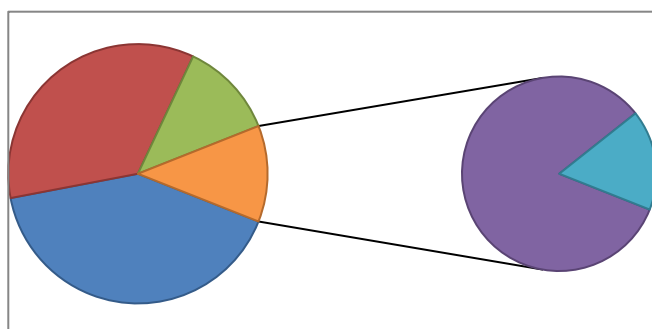

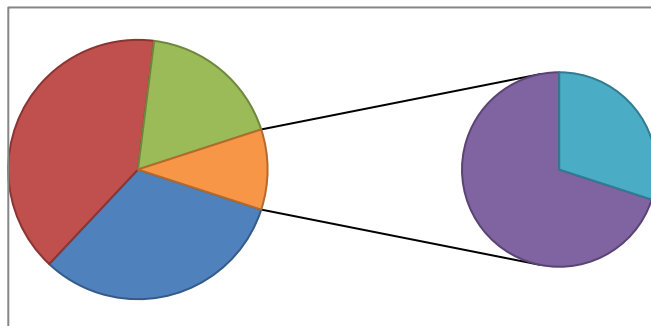

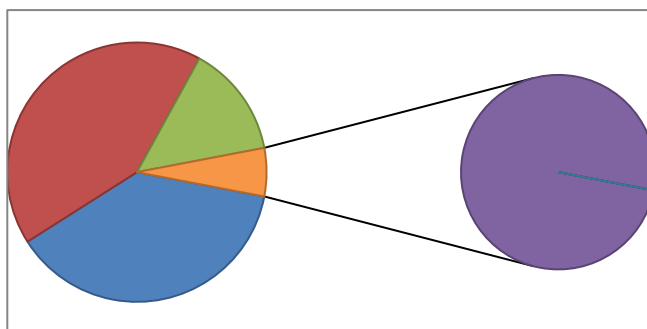

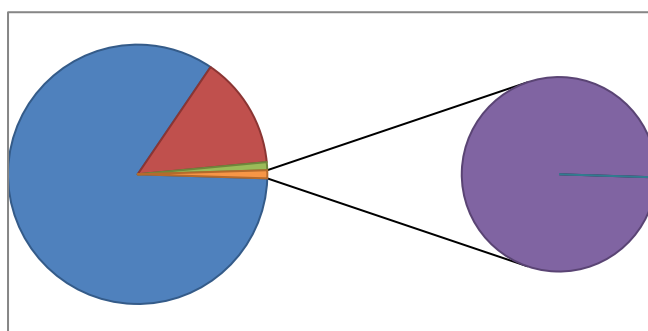

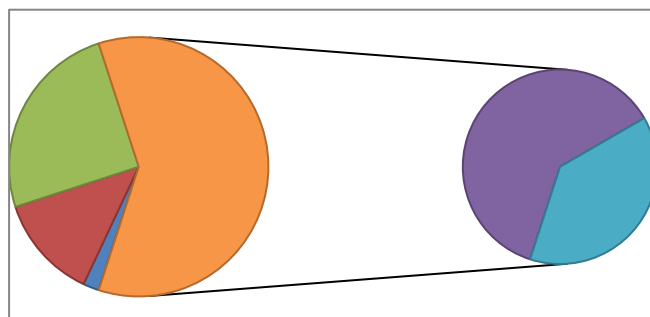

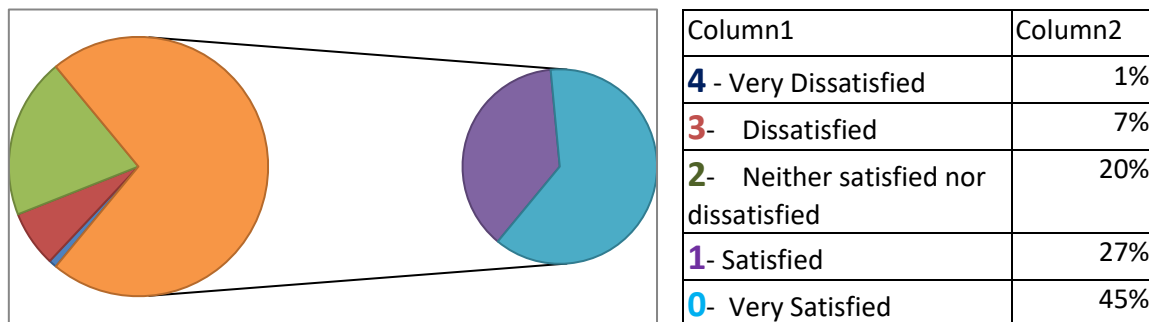

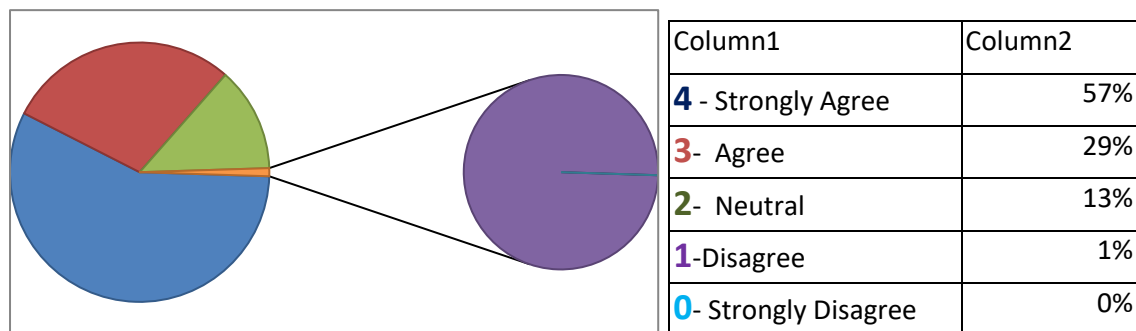


Interpretations:
