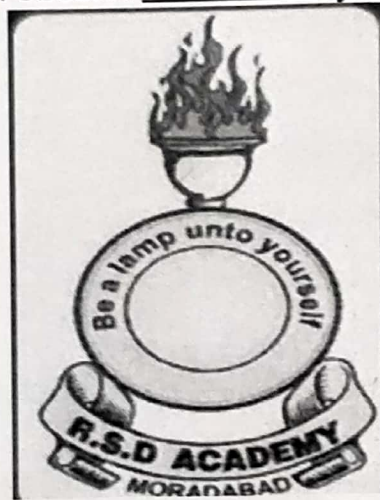
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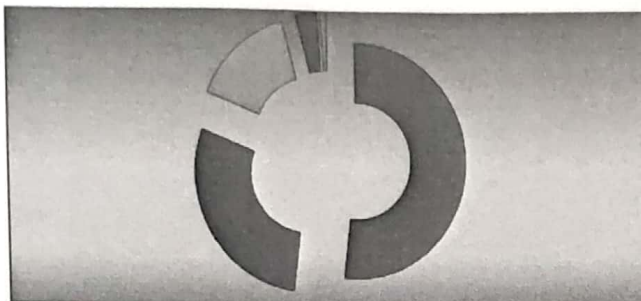
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**Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on Teaching

July 2021 to June 2022**

Following is the report of the survey (SSS) based on responses obtained online from 250 students.

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 219 responses

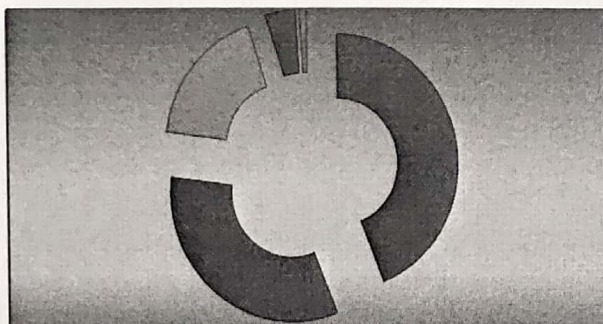

Interpretations:

- ❖ The blue color denotes that 52% of students have said that 85 to 100% of the syllabus has been covered.
- ❖ The red color denotes that 29% of students commented that 70 to 84% of the syllabus has been covered.
- ❖ The green color denotes that 15% of students have reported that 55 to 69% of the syllabus has been completed.
- ❖ The purple color denotes that 3% of students said that 30 to 54% of the syllabus has been done.
- ❖ The light blue color denotes that 1% of students have said that only 30% of the syllabus has been completed.

2. How well did the teachers prepared for the classes? 204 responses

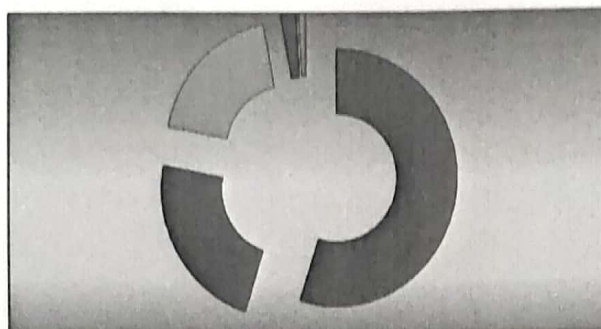

- ❖ The blue color denotes that 44% of students have said that teachers were thoroughly prepared for the classes.
- ❖ The red color denotes that 33% of students commented that teachers were satisfactorily prepared for the classes.
- ❖ The green color denotes that 18% of students have reported that teachers were poorly prepared for the classes.
- ❖ The purple color denotes that 4% of students said that teachers were indifferently prepared for the classes.
- ❖ The light blue color denotes that 1% of students have said that teachers won't teach at all.

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 232 responses

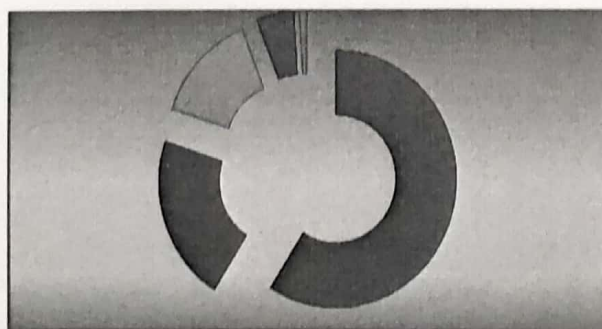

- ❖ The green color denotes that 19% of students have reported that teachers were communicating satisfactorily in class.
- ❖ The purple color denotes that 2% of students said that teachers were communicating in an ineffective way in class.
- ❖ The light blue color denotes that 1% of students have said that teachers have very poor communication in the class.

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can be described as 209responses

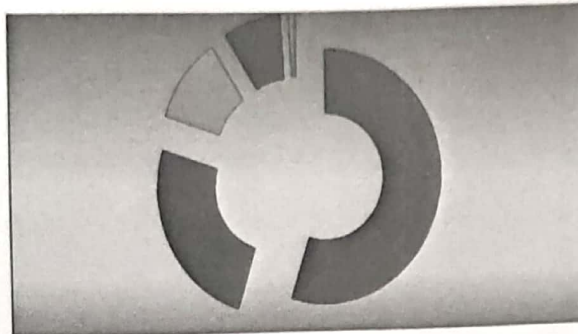

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 216 responses

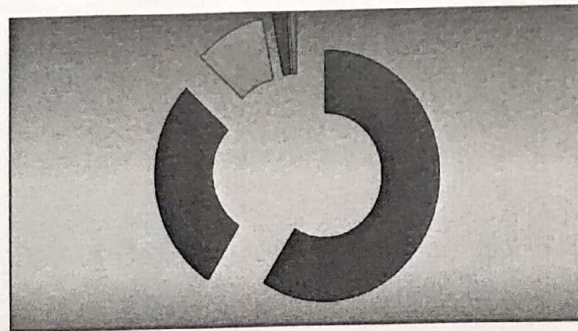

6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 235 responses

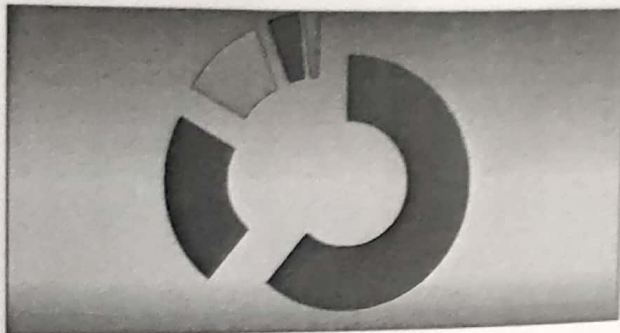

7. Does the institute take active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, and field opportunities for students? 200 responses

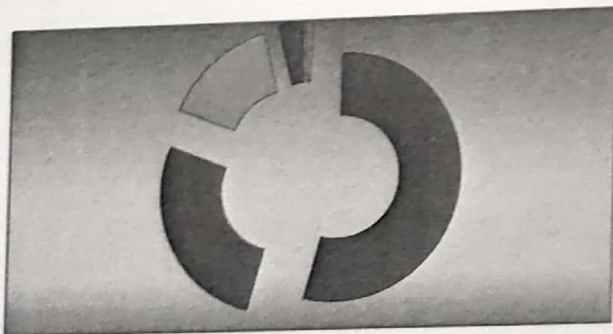

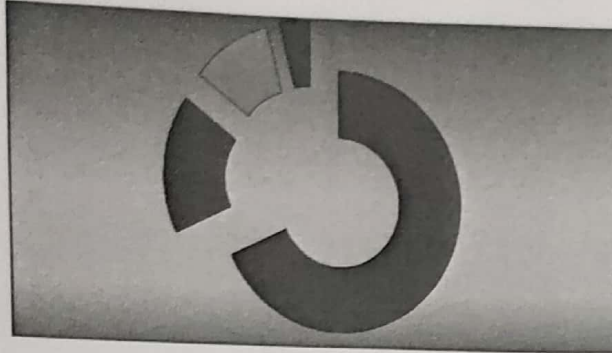
Interpretations:

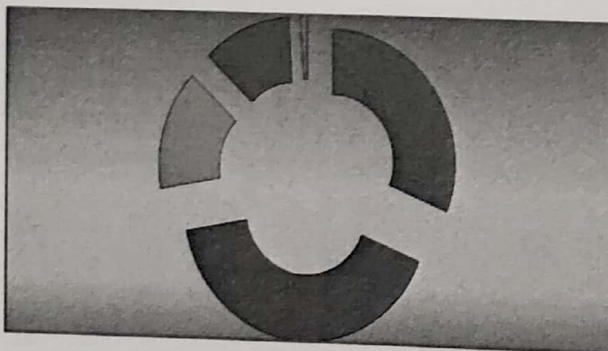

10. Do teachers inform you about your competencies, course outcomes and programs outcomes? 204 responses



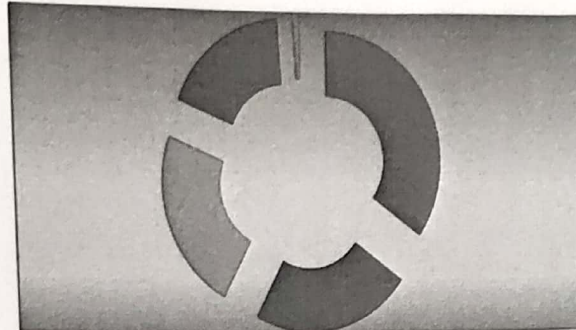

11. Does your mentor do a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you? 200 responses



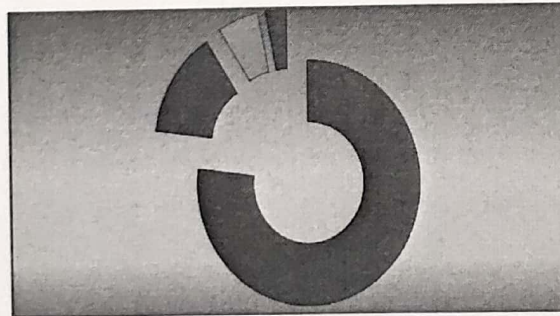

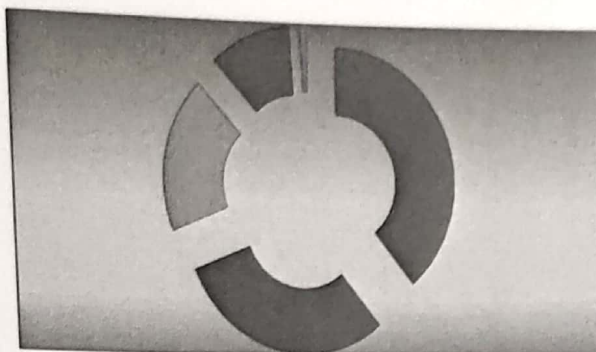

13. Do the teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges? 233 responses

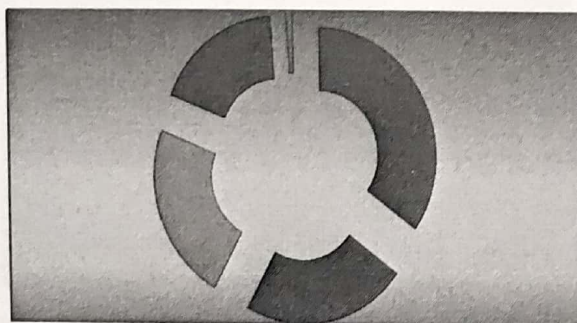

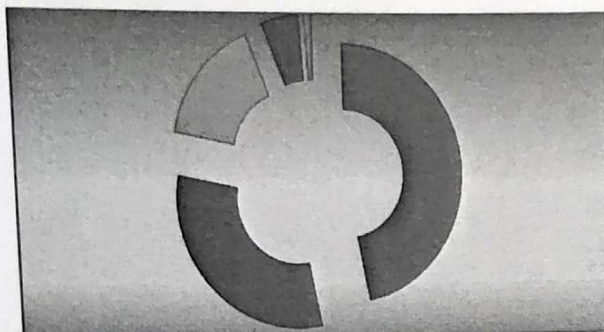
Interpretations:

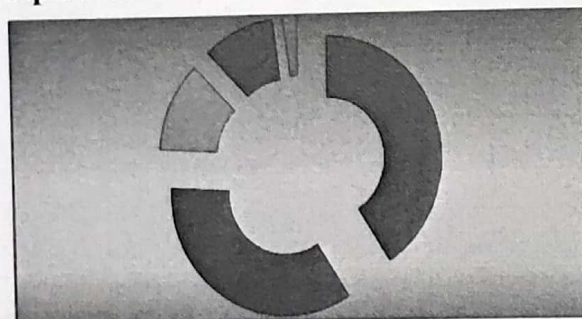

16. Do the institute/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences? 246 responses



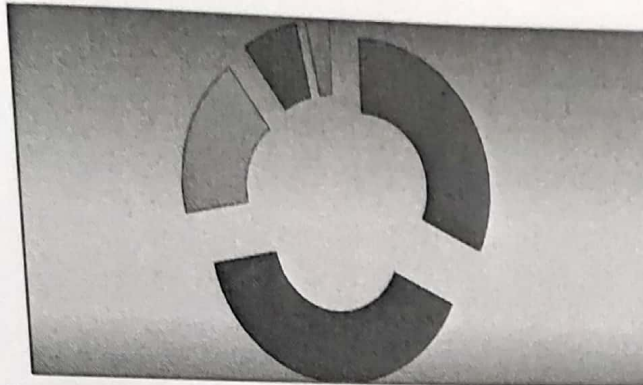

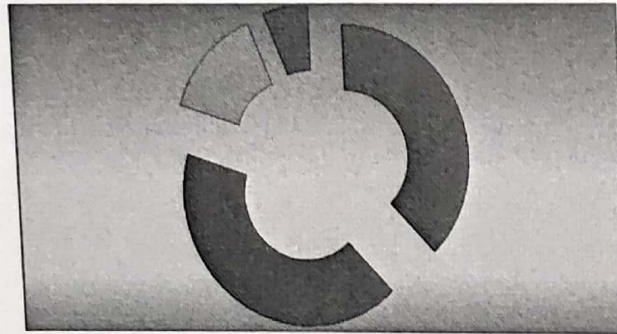

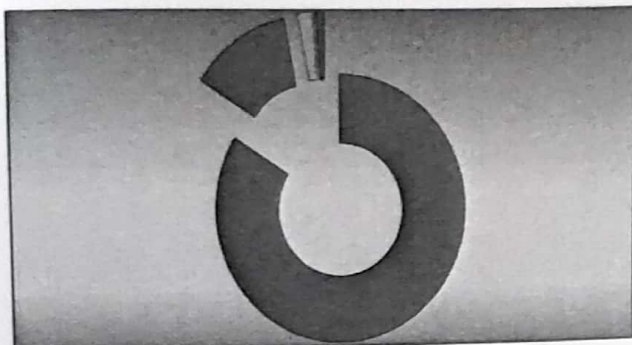

19. What percentage of teachers uses ICT Tools such as LCD Projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching? 241 responses



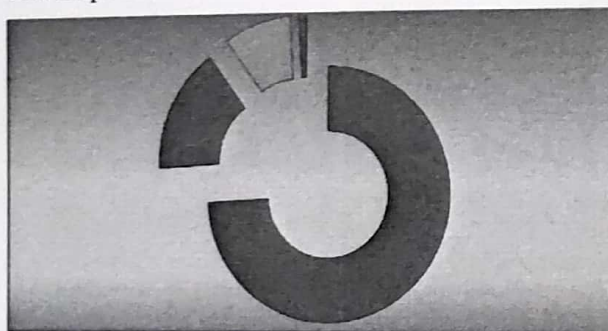
