## Following is the report of the survey (SSS) based on responses obtained online from 130 students.

I. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

$\checkmark$ The blue color denotes that 53\% of students have said that 85 to $100 \%$ of the syllabus has been covered.
$\checkmark$ The red color denotes that $24 \%$ of students commented that 70 to $84 \%$ of the syllabus has been covered.
$\checkmark$ The green color denotes that $20 \%$ of students have reported that 55 to 69\% of the syllabus has been completed.
$\checkmark$ The purple color denotes that $3 \%$ of students said that 30 to $54 \%$ of the syllabus has been done.
$\checkmark$ The light blue color denotes that 1\% of students have said that only 30\% of the syllabus has been completed.
II. How well did the teachers prepared for the classes?

$\checkmark \quad$ The red color denotes that $26 \%$ of students commented that teachers were satisfactorily prepared for the classes.
$\checkmark \quad$ The green color denotes that $10 \%$ of students have reported that teachers were poorly prepared for the classes.
$\checkmark \quad$ The purple color denotes that 5\% of students said that teachers were indifferently prepared for the classes.
$\checkmark \quad$ The light blue color denotes that $1 \%$ of students have said that teachers won't teach at all.

$\checkmark \quad$ The light blue color denotes that $1 \%$ of students have said that teachers were Unfair in the internal evaluation.

$\checkmark \quad$ The purple color denotes that $9 \%$ of students said that the assigned mentor do it rarely.
$\checkmark \quad$ The light blue color denotes that $1 \%$ of students have said that they don't have a mentor.

$\checkmark \quad$ The purple color denotes that $11 \%$ of students said that the teachers slightly encourage them.
$\checkmark \quad$ The light blue color denotes that $1 \%$ of students have said that the teachers were unable to identify their strengths.

$\checkmark \quad$ The green color denotes that $25 \%$ of students have reported that the teachers use ICT Tools up to 50 to $69 \%$ while teaching.
$\checkmark \quad$ The purple color denotes that $18 \%$ of students said that the teachers use ICT Tools up to 30 to $49 \%$ while teaching.
$\checkmark \quad$ The light blue color denotes that $7 \%$ of students have said that the teachers use ICT Tools below 20\% while teaching.
